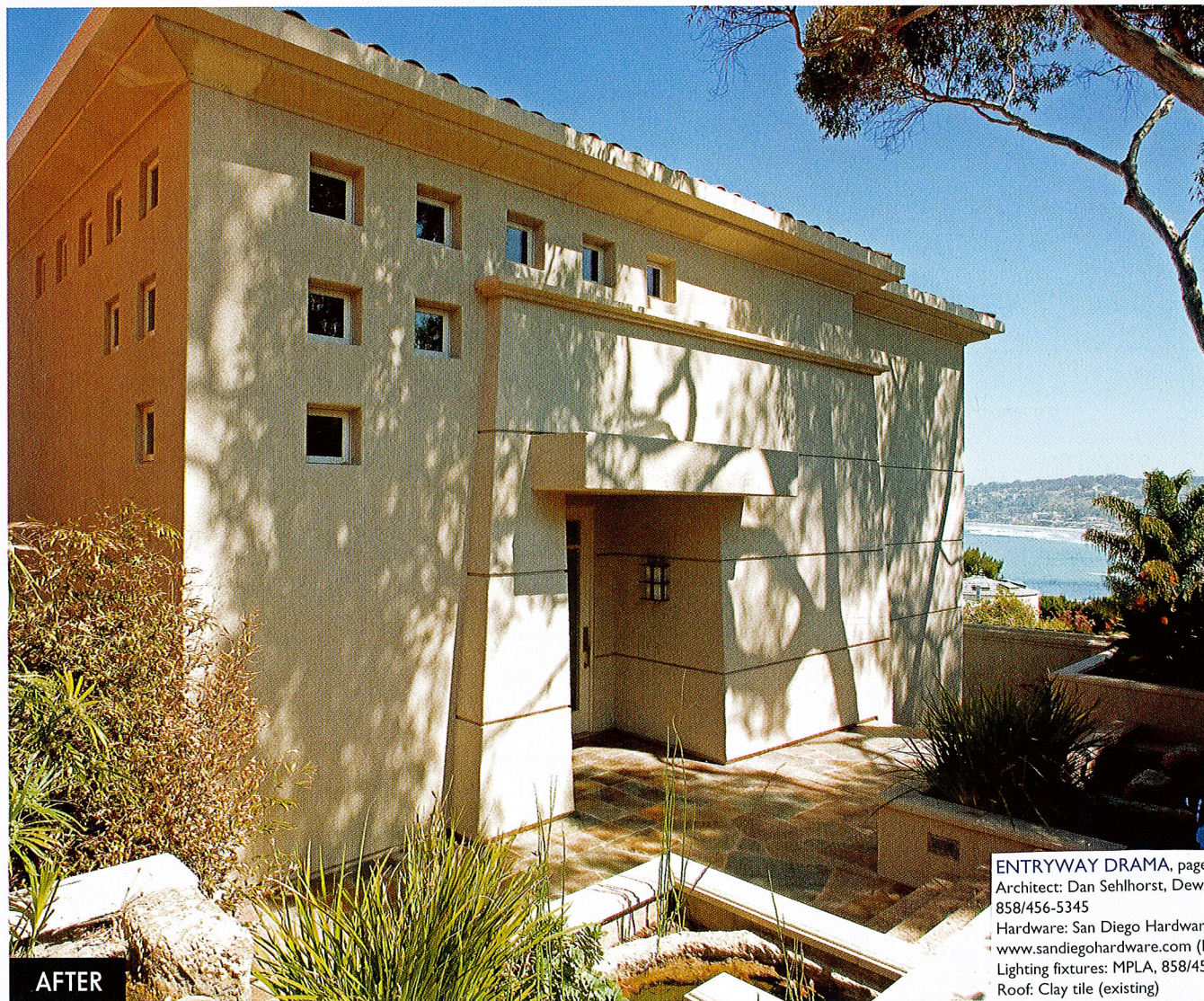


ENTRYWAY DRAMA

Architect Dan Sehlhorst revamped a moisture-damaged Torrey Pines residence, transforming a dated '80s design into a contemporary masterpiece. To avoid the chaos from a major coastal roadway adjacent to the entry, Sehlhorst thickened the stucco exterior walls to reduce the traffic noise and introduced 16 small recessed windows that lighten a previously dark portion of the building. ■
